Upon Arrival:

- Please notify the staff at Reception if you have any signs or symptoms of any illness. Please consider delaying your visit if you are feeling ill, or have been exposed to anyone that is sick.
- You are not currently required to show proof of a negative COVID test. However, if you would like to take a COVID test prior to your visit, Woodland Pond can provide one to you at no cost to you.

During your visit:

- Sanitize your hands immediately at the onset of your visit and right before your departure. *(Alcohol hand gel will be provided).*
- Please try and follow the recommendations we made above. We are not permitted by NYS Department of Health to require advance testing nor vaccination of any guest. So, we must rely on each individual to help us keep our staff and residents virus and illness free.

After your visit:

- If you develop any symptoms of illness during the next 14 days after your visit, you must notify Woodland Pond infection control team, by calling the reception desk at ext. 5910 and asking to speak with nursing administration.
